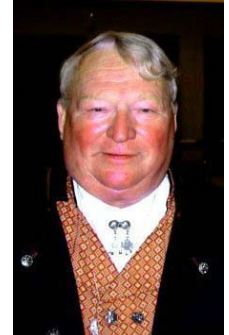
We had a very busy District Board meeting in March which was highlighted by a partial lease payment to 3D Ltd from the LOV board. This was the first lease Payment in many months and was the result of hard work by many people. 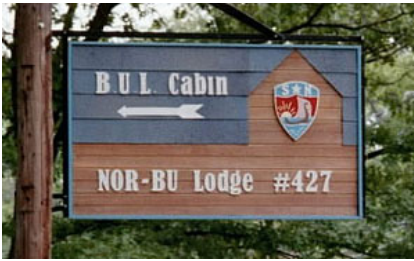

## SAS Expands Routes

SAS also plans to introduce additional European flight frequencies throughout early 2011, with a total of more than 150 additional departures per week on key routes.
